Chris Lee shows potential in early filing

Prosecutor and Deputy District Attorney raises \$1000 per day in preparation for Justice of the Peace bid

Deputy District Attorney Chris Lee had only 13 calendar days at the end of December to raise donations in his race for Justice of the Peace but managed to average better than \$1000 a day according to the report he filed today.

Judicial candidates were restricted from fundraising until December 19th of last year. From that date, Lee raised \$13,190 and spent nothing.

“I’m fortunate that friends and family were among the first to support my race,” Lee said. “That support gives my campaign a big lift going into 2006, and I’m already getting a positive response to my second round of fundraising.”

Lee is running for Justice of the Peace, Department 2, North Las Vegas Township. He has lived in Southern Nevada since he was two years old. A graduate of Gorman High School, Occidental College and Santa Clara School of Law, Lee currently serves as a prosecutor in his capacity as a Deputy District Attorney here in Clark County.

Lee is married and continues his work in professional organizations and volunteer activities.
