Prosecutor Chris Lee seeks judicial post

*Deputy District Attorney cites professional experience,
commitment, values*

Prosecutor and Deputy District Attorney Chris Lee announced his candidacy for North Las Vegas Justice of the Peace, Department 2 today citing his professional qualifications, commitment to community work, and personal values.

“While I love the challenges of serving as a criminal prosecutor, I look forward to the new challenges as a judge involved in the community—working with local leaders, rank and file police, and law enforcement at all levels to help build a safer community for us and our families,” Lee said.

Lee also emphasized full community involvement, saying, “I also want to be a judge who is involved in the whole community, working with our youngsters, our elderly and those neighborhood activists who help make North Las Vegas a decent place to live and raise a family.”

Lee sees the North Las Vegas position as, “offering the opportunity to roll up our sleeves and get involved in the community in a way where we can actually see the results. I know I have both the qualifications and experience to be a good judge. I also have experience in life, and I want to use that experience to expand my participation.”

Chris Lee has lived in Southern Nevada since he was two years old. He and his wife reside in North Las Vegas. “As the son of immigrants, I know the value of hard work, of family, of dedication,” Lee said. “I want those values to show in my courtroom and in my activities in North Las Vegas.”
