LAS VEGAS—Chris Lee, supported by off-duty North Las Vegas police officers, filed for North Las Vegas Justice of the Peace, Department 2 today.

Lee, a prosecutor and Deputy District Attorney, was flanked by North Las Vegas police officers as he filed his paperwork for the office. “As a candidate for judge, I’m proud to have the support and endorsement of our police officers,” Lee said. “The first priority of any judge is to help secure public safety, and the men and women of our police force are a big part of that fight. I’m glad to have them at my side.”

“As a prosecutor I’m able to help our community, but I believe that as a judge I can do even more,” Lee said. “I want to be a good, honest and fair judge. But I also want to be a judge who is active in our community, who rolls up his sleeves and works with civic and charitable groups to help make North Las Vegas an even better place to live or work.”

Lee has the endorsement of the North Las Vegas Police Officers Association, the North Las Vegas Fire Fighters Association and the North Las Vegas City Employees Association. “My work as a prosecutor gives me the background necessary to be a good judge. And support like this lets the

community know I've met the test. I'm dedicated to running hard and getting my message out to the voters of North Las Vegas," Lee said.

While this is his first run for office, Lee is well known in the legal community and, in addition to his early endorsements, Lee has mounted a successful fundraising effort.
