JP candidate Chris Lee gains momentum with new law enforcement endorsements

New candidate continues to add support to his campaign.

Chris Lee, candidate for North Las Vegas Justice of the Peace, Department 2 added to an already impressive list of endorsements with the announcement that three additional law enforcement organizations are backing his candidacy.

The Las Vegas Police Protective Association, the Clark County District Attorney Investigators Association, and the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Managers and Supervisors Association have endorsed Lee's bid for office.

Lee, a prosecutor and Deputy District Attorney, welcomed the endorsements saying, "Justice Court is the first stop in many felony and assault cases. I'm convinced our community needs a judge who served on the front lines and understands the unique issues that face our criminal justice system. I believe these endorsements show confidence not only my ability to be a strong judge, but also in my ability to win this election."

Lee previously gained the endorsements of the North Las Vegas Police Officers Association, the North Las Vegas Fire Fighters Association, and the North Las Vegas City Employees Association, the three groups working directly with the public in the North Las Vegas Township.
